
Attendance at Events by Foster Dogs Policy

Purpose:

The purpose of the Attendance at Events by Foster Dogs Policy is to regulate when foster dogs can and cannot attend CCR events.

Scope:

Foster Homes

POLICY

I. Policy Statement

CCR foster dogs are a welcome addition at CCR events yet there are times when their attendance is prohibited.

II. Procedure

- a. Foster dogs must be in the CCR program for no fewer than 14 days before being eligible to attend CCR events.
- b. In foster homes with multiple dogs, foster dogs exposed to new foster dogs must also experience the 14 days quarantine.
- c. No dogs with sickness, illness or a contagious condition will be allowed to attend events.
- d. All dogs must be well mannered. They must be known to be safe and trustworthy with all animals and humans. They cannot have any leash reactivity.
- e. Puppies must have had their second set of vaccinations, be dewormed and be considered healthy.
- f. All adult dogs must be current on their vaccinations.
- g. An Initial Observation Form and any Foster Dog Update Forms must have been completed at the appropriate time, and approval given for the dog to either be eligible for adoption or to attend the event.

- h. Dogs with adoption applications pending may not attend adoption events, but are welcome to attend events aimed at public relations. Special considerations may be made by the Coordinator team.
- i. All dogs must have a handler assigned to them at the event who is able to control and remove the dog, if needed.
- j. Dogs must have on a collar and ID at all times. Due to the risk of dogs pulling out of their collars and harnesses, it is encouraged to use slip leashes along with the standard collar and leash.
